Portfolio Checklist

- Front cover including: your name, Class of 2019, and an image that represents you
- Cover Page / Letter of introduction This should include a recent (and tasteful) photograph. It is an introduction to your portfolio with other relevant information (i.e. areas of interest, plans for the future, special skills or talents).
- Resumé
- Letter of Recommendation personal data form (provided)
- Two Letters of Recommendation (Only one from a NUAMES faculty/staff member)
- Personal Statement Assignment
- Senior Exit Survey (provided) Mentors will collect these.
- Samples (artifacts) of creative work: memoirs, essays, poetry, short stories, original artwork
- Samples (artifacts) of academic work: research, essays, projects
- Awards, certificates and significant letters (i.e. Letters of Acceptance)
- NUAMES and university transcripts
- Anything else that might enhance the portfolio
