Scholarship Value: \$20,000-\$50,000 (10-15)

Seniors

Must show evidence of strong academics (3.7 GPA or higher), leadership, community service, participation in extracurriculars, and a desire to make positive impact on the world around them. Submit the application, transcripts and 2 letters of recommendation. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, and will limit the number of applications reviewed to 3,000.
